The Franklin County L.O.S.S. team (Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors) launched in November, 2014. As we continue to serve those bereaved by suicide in Franklin County we need more volunteers. We are looking for compassionate people who care deeply about those who have lost someone to suicide. This includes those who have lost a friend or family member to suicide, mental-health workers, clergy members and other compassionate community members who want to volunteer to serve survivors.

The LOSS Team consists of several trained volunteers like yourself who - in teams of 2-3 - go to the scene of a suicide to provide resources, support and hope.

At this thorough training you will learn the importance of the LOSS team volunteers, how we partner with the Coroner's Office and Law Enforcement, how we serve survivors, and what to expect as a team member.

By attending this training you are not committing to be a volunteer.
